Introduction

A Note on David Jones of Wallington

David Jones of Wallington, Surrey, was born in 1834, the son of Thomas Jones, malster and farmer of Great House, Llanblethian, Glamorgan. In 1866, David Jones left Glamorgan to seek work in England and by 1879 had made enough money to retire to Surrey. From 1879 until his death in 1890, David Jones researched and collected genealogical and historical material on Carmarthenshire, Cardiganshire, Pembrokeshire, Glamorganshire, Brecknockshire, Monmouthshire, Gloucestershire, Berkshire, Wiltshire, Surrey, Durham County, Somerset and Warwickshire. The greatest bulk of this material is on Glamorganshire and Carmarthenshire. Unfortunately, David Jones died before publishing any of his major works.

The Material Collected by David Jones

A large part of the material consists of extracts of wills of Welsh families, for the the period approximately 1400 - 1800. Twenty eight volumes of extracts are for wills registered at The Perogative Court of Canterbury and nine volumes of extracts are for provincial wills registered mainly at Llandaff and Carmarthen. In 1888 and 1889, David Jones collected monumental inscriptions from nearly every parish church in Glamorgan and these recordings fill twenty five exercise books. David Jones was also a proficient artist and seven albums contain four hundred and fifty nine pen and ink sketches by him of views of Glamorgan. The rest of the material, which is mostly for Carmarthenshire and Glamorganshire, is a vast assortment of notes and extracts on the following : Hearth Tax Returns, Lay Subsidies, Proceedings of the Star Chamber, Plea Rolls, Close Rolls, Patent Rolls, Gaol Files, Fines and Recoveries, Exchequer Bills and Depositions, Signet Office Dockets, Chancery Proceedings, State Papers, Parish Registers and Bishop's Transcripts. For the Counties of Carmarthen and Glamorgan, David Jones indexed this material parish by parish, with the intention of writing a parochial history of the two counties; this work seems to have been the main goal of his eleven years of research.

The Quantity and Location of David Jones's MSS

When David Jones died in 1890, he left the MSS listed in this catalogue, to Tillyd Nicholl of Ham House, Llantwit Major, Glamorgan. Over the years, David Jones had developed a friendship with Tillyd Nicholl, who shared his historical and genealogical interests in Glamorgan and since David Jones had remained single, it was to the Nicholl family that he left his notebooks. In 1938, an Tillyd Nicholl of Ham House, gave the greater portion of the David Jones MSS, to Cardiff Central Library and during the period 1939-40, The National Library at Aberystwyth purchased the remaining MSS from Mr. E.P.W. Nicholl of Llanmaes House, Llanmaes, Glamorgan.

David Jones had also been friendly with T.C. Evans ('Cadrawd') of Llangynwyd, Glamorgan and because Cardiff Central Library has some of David Jones's MSS appearing under 'Cadrawd' MS. Nos., it seems as if T.C. Evans had also acquired some of David Jones' notebooks. Four volumes of David Jones's will extracts came to Cardiff Central Library from a Mr. Gabriel of Caerleon but I don't know how these were acquired by the latter person. Unfortunately, some of the David Jones MSS, have gone missing from Cardiff Central Library and some of the MSS. listed in David Jones's Glamorgan Index MS.4.883, neither appear at The National Library at Aberystwyth, or at Cardiff Central Library. A list of these missing items is given in this catalogue.

If we take into account the total number of individual parts for the one hundred and sixteen different MSS in the David Jones of Wallington Collection at Cardiff, we find two hundred and twelve items in the Collection. Forty two items are contained in the forty one different David Jones MSS, in the Llanmaes Collection at The National Library at Aberystwyth, so making a total from both Libraries, of two hundred and fifty four items. Since some of the notebooks run to over a hundred pages each, it can be seen that a large amount of information is contained in the two collections of David Jones MSS, when taken as a whole.

Introduction Cont'd.

The Background to the Production of this Catalogue

I first came to learn of the existence of the David Jones of Wallington Collection at Cardiff Central Library, through reading a number of articles in the 'Vale of Glamorgan Series' and 'The Glamorgan Historian', published by Stewart Williams. It wasn't until I was in a desperate need to find more information about my family tree that I thought of actually consulting the Collection.

I thought it would be a fairly straight forward business to consult the MSS but this was not to be so. By means of a Special Reader's Ticket, it was easy enough to gain access to the MSS, but it proved almost impossible to make sense of the way in which they had been catalogued. Several years ago, the Library prepared a typescript index for the Collection but this proved to be wholly inadequate in that it only very briefly described the contents of the MSS, and in some cases this description was even misleading. The great fault with the Cardiff Library typescript index of the Collection was that it did not correlate the Cardiff Library MS. numbers with David Jones's own peculiar system of indexing. From an inspection of David Jones's Glamorgan Index, MS 4.883, one could see individual documents being referred to by a variety of numbers assigned by David Jones but there was no immediate way of finding out what exactly they were, or what Cardiff Library MS. numbers had been assigned to them or even if they were in the Library.

In particular, I was looking for David Jones's 'Book 8', but nowhere in David Jones's indexes could I find out what 'Book 8' was and nowhere in the Cardiff Library typescript index could I find a Cardiff Library MS. number for a 'Book 8'. There was no immediate way of being able to differentiate 'Book 8' from the other two hundred odd notebooks in the Collection and the only alternative left to me was to go through them all one by one. This task took me several months after which I thought might as well compile a catalogue, especially so after a South Wales Family History Society friend, Barry Davies of Lisvane, had told me that I would find some David Jones MSS. in the Llanmaes Collection at the National Library. At Aberystwyth, I found forty one more David Jones of Wallington MSS., including 'Book 8' which I had long searched for. Unfortunately, now that this catalogue is finished, it has become obvious that some of David Jones's MS. are neither at Cardiff Central Library or at the National Library at Aberystwyth and are either in private hands or else lost.

Finally, I should like to express my thanks to Barry Davies of Lisvane without whose constant enthusiasm and encouragement this catalogue would never have been finished.
